Have you ever noted that Paul never uses the word in its singular form? It is always plural, saints. Christians are saints because they are members of the holy community—the community of God. It is Christ who is here described as the fullness of God the all-filler.

God's purpose is being achieved in three stages: the fullness of his own divine nature has found complete expression in the man Jesus Christ; He has given Christ, the bearer of his fullness, as his gift to the church, which is to be the first sharer of that fullness; and through the church he intends his fullness to pervade the rest of creation. Some very practical, challenging, and inspiring truths flow from this high and holy understanding of the church. Jesus said to his disciples: "You do not choose me, but I chose you" (Jon 15:16) God chose us to give us those which He alone can give. What bracing power! What motivating inspiration to know oneself chosen by God!
