Proclaiming Jesus Christ as Lord (1 Corinthians 4.5)

If you were to ask St Paul about the purpose of his ministry he could, no doubt (being Paul!) answer at some length. In our New Testament passage from 2 Corinthians 4, however, he gives us a one-line summary of both the purpose and nature of his ministry. As part of his defence against criticism from some within the Corinthian church Paul writes:

We do not proclaim ourselves; we proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your slaves for Jesus' sake. (2 Corinthians 4.5)

Most of us, I hope, would readily accept Paul's summary of the purpose of his ministry as applying also to local churches – surely we have a corresponding purpose to proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord? But we need to recognise what this really means. In Paul's day those living under Roman rule were expected to affirm their faith in Caesar by declaring 'Caesar is Lord'. To proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord was effectively to assert that Jesus is greater than Caesar and that those who heard the proclamation should put their trust in Jesus and not in Caesar (or any other human authority). To proclaim Jesus as Lord means to recognise him as Lord of all, to invite him to rule in our lives, and to call all people everywhere to put their trust in him.
