WELCOME TO ST. LUKE'S DAY

Our guest preacher today is Dr Owen Lewis. Owen and Mary Lewis are old university friends of the Rev Stephen Clark, former rector of St Luke's. They were GPs working in Mt Gambier when they responded to God's call for missionary service with CMS Australia in 1985. They were invited to St Luke's on deputation to speak about their assignment to Nepal. St Luke's supported them in prayer, letters and gifts as they took their four children with them to work in Patan Hospital. After seven years they came home to complete their children's education but went back again in 2000 for another six years as foundation professors of family medicine in a teaching hospital. On return to Australia Mary changed careers and was ordained as a priest. Her postings have been at Roxby Downs with Bush Church Aid, Port Pirie before "retiring" to Campbelltown. Owen continues work as a GP with outback locum and indigenous health focus. He has made numerous trips back to Nepal, India and South Sudan for medical teaching and disability work.
