The first sentences of the Old Testament reading today will be familiar to many as the opening words of Handel's masterpiece, *The Messiah*. "Comfort Ye, Comfort Ye my people,' says your God!" It would be difficult to estimate the millions of people who have heard orchestras, soloists, and choirs proclaiming these words of hope and the promise of delivery from the oppression, despair, and sin of the world.

We hear it in the context of the season, eagerly anticipating the cries of "Hallelujah!" that will come in just two weeks with the birth of Christ. In their original context these words of the prophet Isaiah were words of restoration and hope to the people of Israel who were to return home after almost sixty years in exile. The prophet Isaiah was speaking powerfully about a new beginning, in which God and his people come home. Through Isaiah, God gives a glimpse of what restoration looks like; one with God at the center; a God who is loving even in the midst of passing judgment and righting the injustices in the world, whether that is lifting up those in valleys or leveling those who sit upon pompous mountains. This is no cheap grace being offered, but rather is the reconciling work of a mighty God. This is what we anticipate in Advent; the arrival of God's love. Isaiah presents one vision of that for us today.
