Today we celebrate the miracle of the Ascension of Our Lord; and this is one of those stories that is hard for me to get my mind around. What does it mean that Jesus was "carried up into heaven"? How did this happen? And is Heaven really "up"? What does that mean? We know that even if we had a large enough telescope, we would not be able to look up into the skies and see heaven.

For me, this story is one of many stories in Scripture that I accept on faith – not because they make sense to me, or because I can figure them out – but because it is God's Word to me and I have learned to trust God's word with my heart even when my feeble human mind cannot wrap itself around the magnitude of the mystery that is God.

If you think that you have finally got your mind around God, then it's not God that you have gotten your mind around. God is beyond our comprehension, but not beyond our faith, not beyond our trust. And that is true of much of Scripture, including the Ascension. The Ascension is a mystery that we can't get our mind around, but that we accept in faith, and that brings joy to our hearts because it promises us the power and the presence of Jesus.
