When we read the book of Hebrews we encounter a community of Christians living in a time of trial, a community not so different from ours as we might at first think. Like us they are trying to understand God and God's purposes, even in the midst of struggle and suffering.

The message of the book is our message too – their story is our story.

The specific forms of what will threaten our faith will vary culturally around the world and over time. But the call to faith and the Christ in whom we trust remain the same.

The first century Jewish Christians to whom this letter was written were distracted and discouraged, they faced significant persecution and the temptation to turn away from their faith was strong and pressing.

Endless distractions bombard us. The array of devices and channels through which we can connect to an endless stream of media provide us with never ending temptations to worry or to place our trust in false idols. In the midst of all this we think we're doing ok if we hold it all together and manage to look after ourselves and each other.

In the midst of this it can be difficult to remember to look to Jesus....and yet above every reason for discouragement or distraction from our faith, above our urgent needs, our great High priest, Jesus sits enthroned at the right hand of God. Far higher than the angels in rank and rule. The angels worship him.....they are simply servants.....the messengers....Jesus is the message.
