As Jesus appeared to these two travellers, a Fellowship developed. We have Jesus' guarantee that He will be present wherever two or three people gather in His name. So far as I know, none of Jesus' post-resurrection appearances were limited to a single person. He appeared to numbers two, three, and twelve. Without a doubt, Jesus is capable of appearing to us on His own. However, it occurs more frequently among believers who share their faith and break bread together.

Breaking bread together is a really a most intimate act. Believers gather around the table and share food to maintain life, creating an extraordinary sense of togetherness.

Perhaps heightened awareness is required to discern the ultimate person on our own Emma-us Road. We must live each day with the expectation that Jesus will show Himself to us. Expect the unexpected.
