Prayer Ministry at St Luke's. At St Luke's we are committed to prayer as an important part of our ministry and care for the world and each other. In order to make sure that everyone is informed of prayer needs and can contribute to the ministry of prayer we have the following processes in place.

Each week the pewsheet will contain three prayer lists.

- 1. *Those in need of immediate prayer.* People can request immediate prayer for themselves or others who are experiencing a health or personal crisis, or for those nearing the end of life. People will remain on this list for two weeks unless we are advised to remove their names earlier.
- 2. Those in need of ongoing prayer for health and wellbeing. People can request that their names or the names of others be added to this list if they have longer term pastoral needs. People on this list will be contacted by the Pastoral Care team so that we are aware of the pastoral needs in our community. This list will be managed by the Pastoral Care Team over time. If you wish to add someone to either of these lists, please contact one of the people at the end of the prayer list. It is vital that if you are adding someone to this list that you have sought their permission to have their name published in the pewsheet.
- 3. *Cycle of Prayer.* Because it is important that we continue to pray regularly for each other, every week you will see that a number of parishioners are included in this list. You don't need to request to be on this list, your name will automatically appear several
- times each year if you are on our parish roll. If you do not wish your name to appear on this list, please email stlukesmodbury@outlook.com to let us know. In addition to the lists in the pewsheet we have a couple of other ways that you can participate in the ministry of prayer.
- 4. *Prayer Chain*. The prayer chain is a way in which we can request immediate, once off, prayer on a particular day. If you message or call Julie Nicholls on 0408 191 521, she will send a text to the members of the prayer chain who will pray for you during the next 24 hours. In addition, if you wish to become a member of this important ministry please get in touch with Julie and she will add you to the team and you will receive the text messages with prayer requests from Julie as they are received.
- 5. *Healing Prayer*. On the last Sunday of each month, volunteers from our congregation will offer prayer on the baptistry side of the sanctuary during the distribution of Holy Communion. At this stage we only have volunteers for this ministry during the 9.30am service.
