When storms and chaos threaten us and we are rendered helpless in the grip of fear and anxiety, as people of faith we cry out to God.

Our cry often reveals more about our fear and anxiety than our faith.

When the disciples cried out “Do you not care that we are about to perish?” it was not simply a question about their survival, it was a question about their value.

“Jesus, are we not important enough for you to save us?”

Does God not care when our life is in chaos and the struggle is more than we can bear?

“Peace! Be Still!” With these words Jesus demonstrates his power to control the forces of nature but perhaps the object of Jesus’ command is the disciples fear, as much as the elements of nature.

Deep in our hearts we pray that God will intervene and still the chaos that whirls around us but sometimes the boat sinks anyway. What do we do then? Where is Jesus then?

Jesus’ answer remains the same. “Peace! Be Still!”

What we do with these words can shape our faith and our ability to live wholly in whatever situation we find ourselves.
