Today, our Gospel reading introduces two figures who embody hope: Simeon and Anna. Their lives reveal what it means to live in hope, to wait faithfully, and to trust that God's salvation is on the way. Simeon is described as "righteous and devout," a man who has been "looking forward to the consolation of Israel.". In his words and actions, we see the deep longing of a people waiting for God to intervene, to bring peace, and to fulfill the promises of old. Simeon has lived his life clinging to the hope that he will see the Lord's Messiah before he dies. Guided by the Holy Spirit, Simeon takes the child into his arms and declares, "Master, now you are dismissing your servant in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation. Simeon recognizes in this child the fulfillment of God's promises, not only for Israel but for all nations. Simeon's hope is not passive; it is active, grounded in his faith in God's word and sustained by the Holy Spirit.

This hope enables him to see beyond a poor couple bringing their child to the temple and recognises God's salvation entering the world. Alongside Simeon, we meet Anna, a prophet who has spent decades in the temple, worshiping with fasting and prayer. She has lived with steadfast devotion to God as a way of life in the temple. She, too, recognises the significance of the child Jesus and begins to praise God, speaking about him to all who were looking for the redemption of Jerusalem. Anna's hope is communal. Her proclamation invites others to share in the joy and anticipation of what God is doing through this child.
