Today in our Lent series, we consider one of the more accessible kinds of evangelism. It concerns letting those outside of the faith notice something different in the way we view life, seen in how we react to events impacting us.

Jesus when speaking about how to treat the people we have reason to dislike, endorsed behaviour that probably goes against our natural inclinations. His Jewish hearers knew all about a young man called Joseph, sold into slavery by his older and stronger brothers. Later when the power situations were reversed, Joseph behaved towards them with grace and forgiveness.

If we too decline to use opportunity to take revenge on those who have harmed us, that will be noticeably different. Peter suggests it will provoke questions. He advises us to have a line or two on hand as response. Perhaps we could explain, 'I would hope for your ultimate good, just because you're a person made by God.'

We mostly won't know whether such seeds of faith ever take root and grow, but the more interactions everyone has with Christians who are prepared to be a bit brave and a bit different, the higher the likelihood that faith will grow in their lives. May our lives reflect God's love and grace towards us and all people. Amen.
