Trinity Sunday

"The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God

and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all." (2 Corinthians 13.13)

These words are used routinely by Christians around the world as a prayer of blessing as they conclude church services or meetings. They were originally penned by St Paul around 55AD, just 20 years or so after the death and resurrection of Jesus. This is well before any doctrine of the Trinity was formulated (in fact, the doctrine was not settled until some three hundred years later!) The frequent use of Trinitarian phrases in the New Testament (see today's reading from Matthew 28, for example) shows that the nature of God as Trinity was part of Christian experience long before it was part of Christian doctrine. I think it's the same for Christians today. We may not be able to fully *comprehend* God as 'One God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit' but, as we live out our Christian lives, we *experience* God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. While the pattern varies, most of us I suspect, come to faith firstly through a commitment to Jesus as our saviour and Lord. But then, at some point, we realise that some power had brought us to the point where we could make that commitment, and that power could only be God – God the Holy Spirit. As we go on in our Christian lives with Jesus as our Lord and with the empowering presence of God the Holy Spirit, increasingly we recognise the nature, purpose and love of God the Father.

Meeting to ratify the registration of the new Parish of Modbury and Golden Grove. Under the Constitution of the Diocese, two things must happen before the new Parish can be registered.

1. There must be a meeting (of both congregations together) chaired by the bishop or his nominee at which the following motion must be passed by a majority of those present and voting. The motion is defined in the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution and reads: "That this meeting, comprising members of The Anglican Church of Australia the pastoral care of whom has been committed to one or more members of the clergy licensed thereto by the Bishop being desirous of being registered as a parish under the title of the Parish of Modbury and Golden Grove hereby requests the Synod to register such parish."

Note that the motion is not able to be amended, apart from the name of the Parish (with which both Vestries agreed) the wording is set by the Schedule.

2. The second thing is that the Archbishop must appoint a Locum to provide pastoral care for the Parish until a new incumbent is appointed (on the recommendation of a Nomination Committee elected at the initial Vestry meeting of the new Parish)

The meeting will be held on Sunday 18th June at 11am at St Luke's. The Archbishop has nominated the Rev'd Don Owers to chair the meeting.

Acknowledgement of Country.

At its meeting on Saturday 20th May the Parish Council had a constructive discussion about the use of the Acknowledgement of Country. Differing views were expressed by members of the Council and this, no doubt, reflects the range of views in the congregation. As a way forward the Council proposed that we should try a form of acknowledgement that recognises the Kaurna people as the traditional custodians of the land but does not create disquiet by trying to say too much. We resolved to draft a form of words for this and to trial having this said by the service leader prior to the start of the service, starting from next Sunday. The draft wording is below. Please feel free to offer some feedback prior to the next Council meeting on Saturday 17th June.

We acknowledge the Kaurna people as the traditional custodians of the lands on which we meet. We recognise their deep feelings of attachment to country, and we respect their ongoing spiritual connection to the land.
