"Death, be not proud," John Donne admonishes, and St. Paul cries, "O death where is thy victory, O death where is thy sting?" Both John Donne and St Paul trusted that Jesus had defeated the power of death but that did not mean they escape the pain of grief and sorrow which is an inevitable part of life. The gift of love through Jesus Christ does not save us from the reality and the sorrow of death. Even Jesus, confronted by the death of his dear friend Lazarus and the immense grief of his sisters, broke down and wept.

Today, as we remember those we have loved and lost and all the saints within the blessed communion, we are allowed to weep and to be sad. We may trust that the story has a happy ending but that doesn't mean that we don't cry in the sad bits. This kind of grief is a sign that we are human and that human connections matter. They mattered greatly to Jesus of Nazareth.

But we are also urged toward hope and not despair. "Did I not tell you," Jesus reminds the grieving Martha, "Did I not tell you that if you believed, you would see the glory of God?" We cling to the assurance of the One who said, "I am making all things new. . . I will be your God and you will be my children."
